A former auto garage is reborn as the Valley's most talked-about wellness sanctuary—where post-war bones meet biologic brilliance.



In the heart of Phoenix's thriving 7th Street corridor, a bold new vision for wellness architecture has taken root. Swiss Biologic Dentistry, a trailblazer in holistic oral health, has unveiled a meticulously designed sanctuary that's fast becoming one of the city's most talked-about spaces.

Here, wellness is not a buzzword—it's a blueprint. Every element of the building speaks a carefully constructed visual and emotional language. Texture calms. Light guides. Materials ground. It's a symphony of sensation, orchestrated to dismantle clinical coldness and replace it with something profoundly human.

WHERE RAW ARCHITECTURE MEETS RESTORATIVE NATURE

At the helm of the transformation is Swiss Biologic CEO Matt Ellingson, whose creative direction fuses aesthetic daring with a deep reverence for wellness. Every design decision—down to the

curve of a chair or the grain of a wall—serves one radical purpose: to calm the nervous system and invite healing. "The dental chair has long been a symbol of anxiety," says Ellingson. "We wanted to subvert that. This space is about softening edges—literal and emotional. It's about being surrounded by beauty that speaks to the body and the mind."

Instead of razing the 1940s-era structure, the team chose to resurrect it. The original red brick was exposed and celebrated. Polished concrete floors, once tread by grease-stained tires, were reborn as minimalist canvases. Even the trusses were salvaged and highlighted, casting bold lines that echo the building's industrial roots—now wrapped in warmth.

DESIGN DETAILS THAT DISARM AND DELIGHT

- **Garden-Facing Operatories:** Each treatment suite spills open to a private, plant-rich courtyard—an intentional escape for the senses, often dotted with meandering desert tortoises.

- **Biophilic Philosophy:** Layered textures, greenery, and filtered natural light bathe every room, drawing the outdoors in and stress levels down.
- **Sustainable Everything:** From permeable decomposed granite parking to low-impact metals like brass and copper, eco-consciousness flows through the bones of the building.
- **Elevated Acoustics:** Floating ceiling panels soften soundscapes while doubling as modern sculptural elements—a rare fusion of function and form.
- **A Waiting Room That Waits for No One:** This is no antiseptic holding zone. Think: buttery leather seating, curated art and garden books, and vintage photo archives—more boutique hotel than health clinic.

THE NEW LANGUAGE OF WELLNESS ARCHITECTURE

Swiss Biologic Dentistry isn't merely reimagining what a dental space can be—they're pioneering an entirely new dialect in the architecture of healing. This isn't a redesign. It's a revolution in how we shape environments that nourish the human body, mind, and nervous system. "Every surface, every corner, is an invitation to exhale," Ellingson adds. "From the moment you walk through our doors, you're not just entering a clinic—you're entering a story. One of restoration, intention, and care."
