



What Makes Ceramic Implants Better?

Functionality: Implants allow for the maximum amount of normal biting and chewing force you can achieve from a restorative process. Upon integration, the implant is practically fused to your jaw bone. That process is called osseointegration since bone has literally grown around the implant to hold it in place.

Longevity: Current ceramic technology has come a long ways and current ceramic implants can last many decades. In fact, they often have longer lifespans than the crowns!

Aesthetics: Ceramic implants are essentially tooth colored even though they aren't specifically lab created for a particular shade. Metal implants are dark grey, and you can often see the metal ring at the gum line. This is especially true the older you get as your gums recede more and more.

Bio-compatibility: This is a metal free office. All implanted metals corrode when in contact with biological fluids releasing metal ions into the implant tissue thereby stimulating the immune system to trigger toxic, inflammatory, or allergic reactions with both local and systemic manifestations.





We only use 100% metal-free ceramic implants. Ceramic implants are the closest approximate to natural tooth roots in terms of aesthetics and function. You never have to worry about metal showing while you smile here! They are very well tolerated, are completely free of metallic corrosion, and conduct neither electricity nor heat.



Immediate Implants

Our office is one of the very few in the Valley that offers same day implant placements. If you need an extraction and implant, most offices perform these procedures separately. That increases your costs, pain, and wait times. Our Swiss-based immediate implant placement protocols are on the cutting edge in the implant world.

The protocols get you healing faster while providing superior bone integration over other two-step procedures. It's never been easier to get implants!

Our Implant Procedure

We only use 100% metal-free ceramic zirconia implants and we can usually perform the procedure in one visit. If you are getting an extraction and implant, the procedure begins with the extraction of the tooth, then a blood draw to extract Platelet Rich Fibrin (PRF), perhaps a small amount of graft material from your body is placed into the implant site, and some ozone therapy. The implant is placed, sutured up, and the healing process begins. After about six months, the bone will integrate around the implant site and the crown and abutment will be ready to be placed. A little time, a couple of visits, and voila, a new tooth!

Ozone Therapy


Ozone is a powerful oxidant. Bacteria, viruses, fungi and parasites have little or no antioxidant enzymes in their cell membranes.

Without this protection, ozone oxidizes (burns a hole through) the cell membrane causing it to rupture, resulting in cell death. Healthy cells have antioxidant enzymes in their cell membranes and are not harmed by therapeutic levels of ozone. Water treatment research in Europe has demonstrated that ONE MOLECULE OF OZONE has the oxidizing power of more than 3000 molecules of chlorine.

90 Years of Ozone Therapy

Did you know Ozone Therapy has been around since the 30's? Ozone started being used in Germany for dental procedures by Dr. E.A. Fisch over 90 years ago!

Bone Grafting



The ideal bone grafting material is your own bone. In most cases we will harvest small amounts of bone from the extraction site. This bone is then mixed with the patient's **PRF** (Platelet Rich Fibrinogen), obtained from a blood draw. This is then placed back in the extraction site. Using the healing properties from your own body is the best way to avoid foreign materials and get the best results!

Platelet-rich Fibrin (PRF) is applied to a surgical wound to induce rapid hemostasis and accelerate the healing process. **Because PRF is** rich in platelets, there is a high concentration of hemostatic and growth factors delivered directly to the wound. The activated platelets initiate the coagulation cascade to stop capillary bleeding and seal any disruptions in the lymphatic system.

Orthodontics has moved far beyond braces. The goals of orthodontics these days is more than just straight teeth, it is about changing the structure of how you eat and how you breathe.



The best part is that if you can change the way you or your child eats and breathes, through what we like to call 'Biologic Ontho', the teeth become straight almost automatically.

To get the best results of our Biologic Ortho program, we often end up using a range of different appliances customized to you or your child's situation. That level of customization is critical in providing the highest level results and the most natural of results. Every person is unique, and so are our treatments.

Additionally, we are very happy to introduce our high capacity digital scanner. We have almost completely eliminated the need for those goopy impressions which can be incredibly uncomfortable.



EXPANDERS

Most of our ortho appliances are removable and do not need to be worn all-day.


However, the patient does need to comply with our office's instructions on how long each day the appliance should be worn.

CASE STUDY: Male child's extreme overjet



At the beginning of treatment, patient experienced severe overjet on the maxillary arch and crowding on the mandibular arch. Patient was very compliant with treatment and was able to complete treatment in 14 months.

CASE STUDY: Female child w/ early crowding



Patient experienced moderate crowding with corresponding airway obstruction. Myobrace treatment was successful with minor post treatment myobrace usage needed to maintain space. Usage to be phased out entirely within 12 months.

Biologic Restorations are Better

Our restorative processes integrate the best biological dental practices including the use of sedative fillings, <code>silven nitrate</code>, platelet rich fibrin (<code>PRF</code>), and ozone. We are extremely conscientious about doing our best to keep as much of your original tooth structure as possible. Nothing is better than your original teeth and every dentist should go out of their way to try and save as many teeth as possible. Unfortunately, most dentists work on volume and aren't as interested as our office is in saving your tooth structure.

But, there does come a time when more invasive procedures are necessary. It happens. And when it does, we make sure that the materials that go in your mouth are as biocompatible as possible and look as close to the original tooth as possible.

Also, we are sensitive to your biocompatibility needs. We can have a lab run tests on what materials you may have an allergic reaction to. We can also replace metal restorations with ceramic. Let us know if you have any concerns about the metal that may already be in your mouth. This is a metal-free office, so we place zero metal anything.

Silver Nitrate's application on the cavity site does not cure the cavity, per se, but it does arrest the growth of the bacteria that causes the cavity and gives the body time to repair the tooth naturally. Most people are not aware that the body can actually heal cavities on its own. This usually works for smaller cavities, but we will also try on larger ones as well to halt as much decay as possible. We believe that where the body can heal itself, it should be given an opportunity to do so. Silver nitrate works quite often, but not always, and in those cases, we will proceed with a filling.



Our (S.M.A.R.T.) Mercury Removal Process

S.M.A.R.T. = Safe Mercury Amalgam Removal Technique:

- Patients are given chlorella, an adsorbent to rinse and swallow before the procedure;
- Protective wear, including gowns, face shields, head and hair coverings, are worn by all Dental staff and the Patient to prevent any contamination on the skin or clothing;
- Respiratory grade masks, rated to capture mercury, are worn by the dentist and all dental personnel in the room;
- The Patient receives external oxygen delivered via a nasal mask preventing the inhalation of any mercury vapor or amalgam particulate during the procedure;
- To prevent swallowing of mercury particulate, a dental dam appliance, with additional suction, is placed in the patient's mouth;
- To reduce the amount of mercury vapor and particulate released, the amalgam is sectioned into chunks and removed in as large of pieces as possible. An electric drill hand-piece is turned to a low speed to reduce heat and keep ambient mercury levels as low as possible;
- Once the removal process is complete, the patient's mouth is flushed with water and then rinsed out with chlorella again;
- Patients are enrolled in a multi-phase regime of liposomal vitamins. Liposomal vitamins have a higher absorbency than traditional vitamins, second only to IV vitamin delivery.

What is an Amalgam Filling?

A mercury filling is the traditional filling that has been used by dentists since the 19th Century. Also called an amalgam filling, a mercury filling consists of about 50% mercury. Silver, tin, copper and other metals make up the other 50%. Modern composites are superior in every way.



I Should See My Dentist About My Sleep Issues?

YES! Getting a good night's rest is critical to long term health and if you are having difficulty falling asleep or getting good, restful sleep, we may be able to help. One of the most important aspects of sleeping involves getting sufficient air while you sleep. We have a range of appliances that actually change the airway passages, allowing for **maximal air intake**. A couple of our appliances have orthodontic applications as well, but opening up the air passages remains a critical component.

If you are having sleeping issues and you think it may be related to breathing issues, you should contact us right away. You may also want to get a sleep test performed to make sure you do not have more serious issues.

GOOD SLEEP HABITS

- Go to bed around the same time regularly;
- Do not drink caffeinated beverages after 2pm;
- Try to avoid watching TV and looking at your phone at least an hour before bed;
- Make sure your mattress is still good;
- Cool your room down;
- Try to relax before bed, and avoid thinking about tomorrow's worries:
- Avoid having LED lights in your bedroom.



Appliances vs. CPAP Machine

If you have ever had to try and sleep with a CPAP machine, you know how hard it is to fall asleep with that massive face mask attached to you. An appliance is a far less intrusive way to achieve similar results. For severe cases, a CPAP machine may be mandatory, but if you are not at that stage yet, you should definitely try an appliance.





Why It Is Important To Maintain Regular Cleanings:

Regular cleanings are an essential part of good oral health for two major reasons: 1) dental cleanings by our hygienists are far more thorough and comprehensive than anything you can do at home, and 2) issues with your teeth can be spotted earlier with less invasive procedures available.

First, it is important to understand why and how our hygienists incorporate our holistic practices. One of the most important things our office gives to hygienists is **time**. Most offices only give their hygienists 45 minutes to set up, perform the cleaning, and the clean-up for the next patient. Our hygienists have more than an hour to devote to each patient. This means a more thorough, deeper cleaning, every, single, time.

Another key difference is our use of ozone, iodine, and essential oils. While our hygienists still use the same hygiene tools that have proven effective at traditional offices, we go further. Our ozone and laser treatment get to the bacteria that live between the gums and your teeth. That's the spot you want to clean most. Other offices just don't get to it. And again, that may also be because we give our hygienists more time.

The third thing is training. Our hygienists are trained to identify and help our dentists diagnose issues using our holistic techniques. Ultimately, it is always the dentists call on what treatment is necessary, but it is always good to have a second set of eyes.


